Figure 8: Monday July 27th & Wednesday July 29th

Tuff Truck : Saturday August 1st

COMMON RULES:

1. No drivers are allowed on the stage with officials during the event
2. Decisions of the race officials are final
 - a. No protests
 - b. All scoring is final
 - c. No video review
3. After determining the winner of the heat, winners must go directly to the impound or be disqualified
4. ALL DRIVERS MUST USE THE ENTRANCE OFF OF SIENA HEIGHTS DRIVE CALLED HANKE LANE
5. Upon injury of a driver, the officials will decide if the heat continues
6. Driver MUST be at least 18 years of age
7. Prize Money:
 - a. All running cars in the final heat will get a cash prize. The number of cars running will determine the prize amount.
 - b. There are NO individual heat prizes
8. CARS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE INFIELD THE NIGHT OF THE RACE!
9. ABSOLUTELY **NO** outside alcohol on the grounds.
10. Officials reserve the right to reject or accept any and all registrations
11. All shows will be open to any year truck, automobile, or station wagon
12. Any drivers or pit crew members not obeying the rules will be disqualified. The driver is responsible for his/her pit crew
13. Drivers must wear a DOT approved helmet and have a seat belt in the car. Full face helmets, five point harnesses, and neck braces are encouraged.
14. **NO HOT RODDING IN THE PIT AREA OR COMING ON TO THE TRACK. NO PASSENGERS IN AND/OR ON THE VEHICLE**
15. The fair volunteers running the show will not be responsible for any personal property
16. If the vehicle is found illegal or does not pass inspection, there will be no refund of entry or passes if the owner does not make it legal
17. Driver MUST attend drivers meeting approximately 15 minutes before show time.

FIGURE 8 and TUFF TRUCK RULES

1. The race is over when the first vehicle completes ten(10) legal laps
2. Second place is determined with the next highest amount of legal laps
3. Vehicles can be entered in all 3 shows(Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday)
4. Each registered driver can only enter a combo of 2 vehicles (truck/truck, car/car, or car/truck)
5. ONLY the registered driver can drive the vehicle

VEHICLE BODY REGULATIONS

1. Gas Tanks

- a. Stock fuel tank MUST be removed and an auxiliary tank must be mounted no further back than the rear seat and be securely mounted

ABSOLUTELY NO STOCK FUEL TANKS!!!!

- b. Fuel tank and lines must be mounted in the rear passenger compartment

- c. A fire shield MUST be placed over the fuel tank

***NO HOUSE INSULATION *NO CARPET *NO CARPET BACKING**
(WELDING BLANKET OR STEEL HOUSING IS RECOMMENDED)

- d. Fuel tank MUST be sealed

- e. NO gas cans!!!

- f. **No more than five(5) gallon capacity will be allowed**

2. Exterior Equipment

- a. You may leave the windshield in the car or truck. There must be two(2) straps from the firewall to the roof approximately 15" from the window post. Straps must have ¼ inch steel, 1 inch wide or 5/16 chain
- b. Chrome moldings, antennas and any dangerous objects must be removed
- c. You may interchange any stock auto bumper
- d. Hoods must be chained closed in four places with chain or #9 wire(two in front and in rear by the firewall) There must be a 24 inch inspector hole in the hood
- e. **NO CONCRETE.** The driver door may be welded solid. No less than 3/16 inch thick steel plate and no less than 18 inches tall. **NO STEEL SQUARE TUBING.** 4x4 angle iron needs to be at least 3 pieces. Guard rail can be used. Whatever option you use must extend 6 inches in front of the A pillar and 6 inches behind the B pillar. If the door isn't welded you MUST securely fasten the door with chains.
- f. All trailer hitches must be removed
- g. You may not fill the tires with anything but air. Wheel weights must be removed. You may run valve stem protectors

- h. NUMBERS MUST BE STANDING UP ON THE ROOF OF THE CAR AT LEAST 14" HIGH AND MUST BE READABLE ON BOTH SIDES!!!! THEY MUST BE SECURELY FASTENED TO THE ROOF!**
- i. The Lenawee County Fair reserves the right to reject any car decorated in poor taste
- j. On all cars you may weld the trunk seams completely and you may have two straps of #9 wire with 3 strands on each side to hold the bumpers onto the trunk only. You must have a 14 inch inspection hole in the trunk.
- k. You may use stock auto bumpers. You may weld bumper shocks. No other welding on the bumper is allowed.
- l. Cutting fenders out is okay for tire clearance
- m. Body bolts may be replaced but must be replaced with no larger than ½ inch bolts or studs. Washer max size on bolts: 2 inches. Bolts may go through body sheet metals and one thickness of frame
- n. A 3" maximum radiator protection pipe or tube is allowed. If used, must be placed behind the bumper in the grill area. The width of the frame rails and supports extending back a maximum of 18"
- o. Tow hooks are encouraged on the front and rear of the car or truck.
- p. NO dual rear wheel trucks
- q. Sunroof needs to be covered with steel

3. Interiors

- a. Sunvisors and any dangerous objects must be removed.
- b. Roll bars may be used in the driver's compartment only. Roll cages are encouraged but not required but MUST stay in the drivers compartment
- c. Rear bottom seat cushion MUST be removed.
- d. There will be no reinforcements on any part of the car
- e. All airbags MUST be disconnected
- f. Vehicle MUST be swept clean, no junk on the passenger seat compartment or trunk
- g. Fire extinguishers are recommended in vehicles, but not required
- h. You may have a floor shifter
- i. Stock automotive drive shafts only
- j. Transcoolers may be mounted in the driver's compartment but must be safe and secure

4. Under Hood

- a. Only an automobile battery is permitted. It must be securely fastened and covered with fireproof material(plastic battery box, welding blanket) anywhere in the car. **NO HOUSE INSULATION, CARPET, OR CARPET BACKING**
- b. Radiator must be in stock position
- c. Cars and trucks must have good working brakes
- d. No starter fluid allowed
- e. There will be no reinforcement on any part of the vehicle
- f. You may run electric fan or solid mount fan
- g. Electric fuel pumps are allowed if they are stock equipment
- h. All holes in firewall must be plugged with NON-FLAMMABLE material
- i. You must have a distributor protector, they must be attached to the engine block
- j. All lug nuts and studs must be secured and in proper working condition
- k. No alterations of the suspension will be allowed
 - i. No air shocks
 - ii. No spring jacks in coil springs
 - iii. No blocked shocks, suspension must move freely

PLEASE NOTE:

CARS AND TRUCKS LEFT AFTER AN EVENT MUST BE PUT IN A DESIGNATED AREA. This area will not be secure, so please do not leave anything of value in the vehicle. The fair is not responsible for any vehicles that are left after the event. ALL VEHICLES MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE GROUNDS BY MONDAY AFTER THE FAIR WEEK. VEHICLES LEFT BEYOND THAT DAY WILL BE DISPOSED OF AS SEEN FIT BY MANAGEMENT OF THE LENAWEE COUNTY FAIR AND EVENTS GROUNDS.
