

Lenawee County Fair

Non-Profit Booth Exhibit Guidelines – July 26 – August 1, 2026 (Schools, Churches, Clubs, Organizations)

- ✓ Booths are available to any Lenawee County non-profit organizations, schools, churches, clubs and organized groups. To keep the focus on the exhibits, participation is limited to non-political organizations.
- ✓ Each booth must have an entry form filled out to participate. **Entry forms and fees are due no later than May 1, 2026.** (Entries received will be on a first come first serve basis.)
- ✓ The entry fee of \$50. is required for a small booth- 10' x 8' (\$25 will be refunded) or an entry fee of \$80. is required for a large booth- 20' x 8' (\$40. will be refunded). Note- Display booths must be completed by the deadline and kept on display through 8/1/26 in order to receive the refund.
- ✓ **Booth setups** may start any time during the week prior to the fair – **July 20 – 24, 2026** from **8:00 am to 9:00 pm. in the Ag Building.**
- ✓ Booths **MUST** be completely set up by **Friday, July 24, 2026, at 9:00 p.m.**
- ✓ There will be no open flames allowed in any booths. Also, there will be no straw, hay or highly flammable items allowed in the booths.
- ✓ Booths may contain items such as fresh flowers, fruits, vegetables, crafts, posters, flags, furniture etc.
- ✓ All items in the booth must be free standing and not attached to any ceilings or walls.
- ✓ It is not required that the booths be manned during fair week.
- ✓ There will be NO buying or selling of any items from any non-profit booths during fair week. Also, NO food or beverages will be allowed to be given away in any booths.
- ✓ The Lenawee County Agricultural Society cannot be responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged items during fair week.
- ✓ Booths may not be dismantled until Sunday, August 2nd through Tuesday, August 4, 2026 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each day.
- ✓ Prize awards will be given to 1st - \$300.
2nd - \$200.
3rd - \$100.
